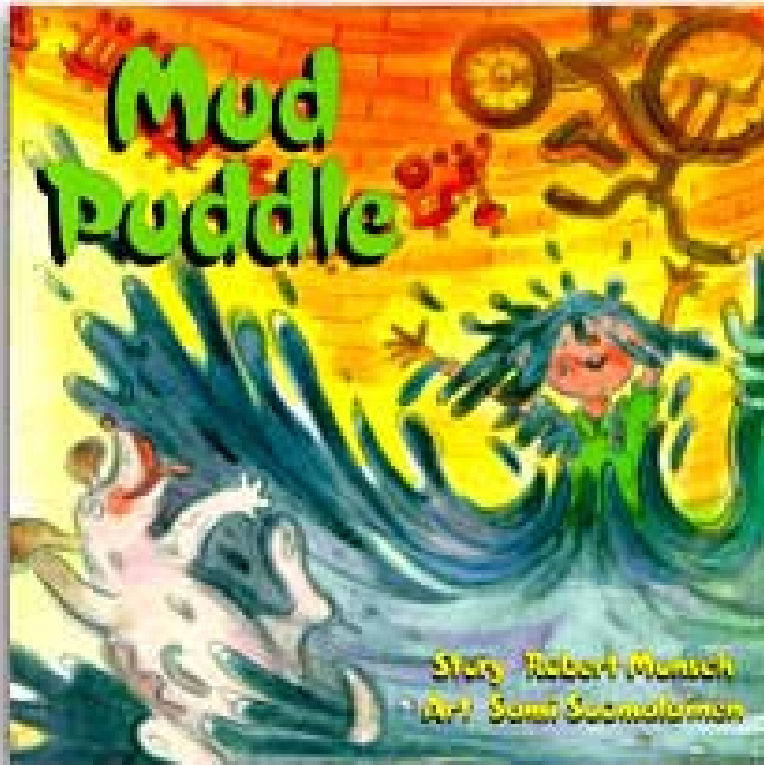


## Mud Puddle by Robert Munsch

### Story Extensions

- Make your own mud puddle. Take a piece of paper and fold it in half. Take some brown paint and place drops of paint along the fold line in the middle of the paper. Have your child refold the paper pressing outwards from the middle. Open up the paper and see the awesome mud puddle!
- Take a field trip to a mud bog truck competition.
- Make mud by mixing dirt and water.
- Go out and play in the rain and mud.
