

## **Eaton County's GREAT START Collaborative**

Minutes: December 7, 2007

Eaton County's GREAT START Collaborative met in a Special Work Session on December 7, 2007 at the Charlotte Assembly of God Church. Ronda Rucker called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and explained the day's process. She provided a template and resources for individual work groups to use in developing Eaton County Great Start strategies for the upcoming fiscal years' work plans. Resources including identified services, identified gaps, and community concerns. A sub-committee comprised of the following individuals volunteered to serve as proof readers of the final document prior to submission: Nikki Selleck, Fran Josefowiz, Kimi Mead, and Debra Williamson. Several individuals suggested that either Donna Turner or Mona Ellard be asked to also work on proof reading.

After work-groups read the developed proposed strategies, Joyce called for a motion to adopt them. Cindy moved to adopt the strategies as read and to authorize Ronda to submit them in the Collaborative's proposed work plan for the upcoming fiscal years after the committee provided proof reading comment. Dave Martin supported the motion. Fran offered an amendment to the motion: "the strategies will be posted on the GSC website prior to submission." The amendment was supported by Lisa, and the amended motion was approved by Collaborative members present.
